
## FIND A LOVED ONE USING YOUR SMARTPHONE

Gethsemani Catholic Cemetery now offers state of the art online mapping for those interred in our cemetery.

To find the location of your loved one using a smartphone we offer the following instructions:

1. Go to our website




2. You will be taken to the Mt. Calvary & Gethsemani Catholic Cemeteries page

Scroll down

Tap on the green [Gethsemani Cemetery Maps](#) button



3. Agree to the above terms and conditions by tapping the square and OK





4. In the white Deceased Name... box (upper left), enter your loved one's Last Name

You can add a comma after the last name and a space followed by all or a portion of their First Name


Names will appear below, simply tap on the name of your loved one



5. You will be zoomed to their location

Use the + or - symbols in the upper left corner or pinch to zoom to see the relative location within the cemetery

Tap the > symbol on the right side of the dark box by your loved one's name to get walking directions. In the next screen (not pictured) tap on [Walking Directions](#)  
**Please use walking directions with caution!**



## WALKING DIRECTIONS:

After you select [Walking Directions](#), Google Maps opens in a separate tab/window. Tap the navigate or arrow to begin Walking Directions. Your location is represented by the smaller white circle - it will move as you move. The red mark represents the location of your loved one. You should ignore the suggested route represented by the blue dots and use your eyes and common sense to get to the location. In the example, the suggested route brings you out to a main public road and the route is not possible to follow because it takes you outside cemetery gates and fences.

Do not rely on the Google Maps voice directions. The interior streets are not correctly named, and verbal directions will be confusing.

Google Maps will only take you within 10' of your loved one's location. As you near your destination, close the Google Maps window and use our map – as seen above in #5 - (zoomed in to see the names in the area) to find your loved one.

**PLEASE NOTE: Walking Directions are a product of Google Maps. Walking directions do not recognize barriers, steep drop offs, fences or other issues that may make their suggested route unusable. When agreeing to the terms and conditions of our map use, you have agreed that the cemetery is not responsible for any issues that may arise from the use of Google Maps or their Walking Directions.**
